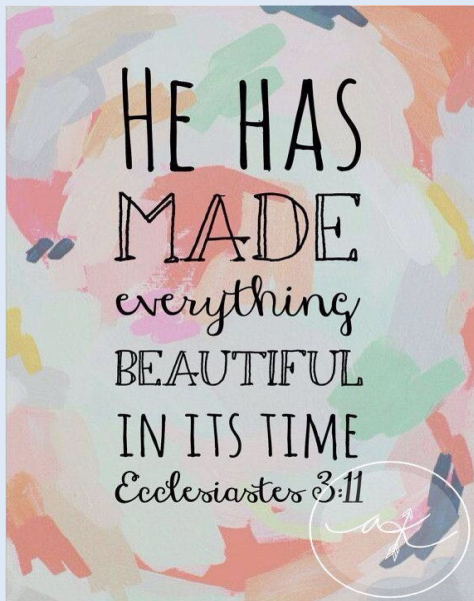

PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE BRING YOUR CHILD TO THE BATHROOM **BEFORE CLASS BEGINS!!!!**

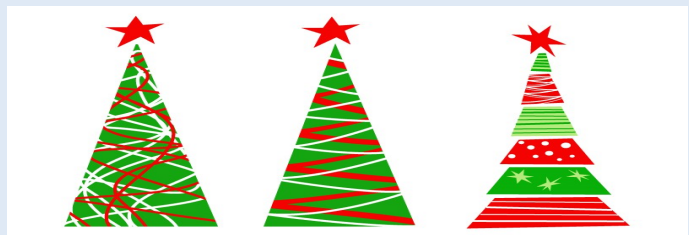
Each child is REQUIRED to have all of the shoes needed for each class!
